## Travel Documents

U.S. Citizens must be in possession of a valid passport with not less than six months validity remaining. Non U.S. Citizens should consult the appropriate consulates.

## Deposits & Payments

A deposit of \$500 per person for the *Sweden Tour* should be submitted with the completed and signed reservation form to confirm your booking. Additional deposit of \$1,500 is due by February 1, 2008. The trip balance is due no later than May 22, 2008.

## Rates & Fares

All rates and fares are those in effect as of September 1, 2007. Prices are based on guaranteed, advanced bookings with each supplier (i.e. hotels); seasonal and occupancy variations may occur. Ingebretsen's, Ted & Diane Noble and Borton Overseas are not responsible for any such price variances. This tour represents a package price and an itemization of individual component cost will not be rendered. The right is reserved to substitute hotel property and location when necessary due to availability, from those described in the brochure. Clients will be responsible for any charges required due to voluntary itinerary deviations at the request of the traveler.

## Changes & Cancellations

Full refund, less 10% of the tour cost per person handling charge, will be made if cancellation is received in writing no later than 60 days prior to departure. Cancellation notice received less than 60 days prior to departure will be assessed the following fees: 59-30 days: 25% of tour cost per person: 29 days, no refund of the tour cost. Airline tickets have their own cancellation and change penalties; all of the above fees are in addition to any airline enforced cancellation fees or other unrecoverable fees from suppliers. No refund for any part of tour you do not utilize or voluntarily change; if you cancel while tour is in progress, there will be no refund of the tour cost for unused portions.

## Trip Insurance

If you choose to purchase Trip Cancellation Insurance, proof of adequate medical and evacuation insurance coverage is required. Insurance purchased within 21 days of your initial payment will also cover most pre-existing conditions (if using our policy with *Travelers*). ## BAGGAGE

Two pieces of checked luggage are permitted, each with a maximum size of 62 near inches (length + width + height) and 50 lbs per piece, and one carry on maximum 13 lbs, and 45 linear inches.

## Frequent Flyer Numbers

Frequent flyer numbers must be supplied to us along with your reservation. Passengers are responsible to reconfirm their number with the airline upon check-in for flights.

**PLEASE NOTE:** A fee of \$25 per passenger will apply should we need to provide ticket copies to obtain frequent flyer mileage credit. Therefore, passengers should retain the passenger receipt of their ticket, plus all boarding passes for flown segments, in the event they do not receive mileage credit from the airline. Please note that airline frequent flyer programs are subject to change. Mileage accrual is not guaranteed.
